

**PERFORMANCE OF STATE VIGILANCE ORGANISATION IN  
NUTSHELL DURING THE YEAR 2016**

During the year 2016, the State Vigilance Organisation has registered 575 criminal cases against 1099 accused persons including 162 Class-I officers, 104 Class-II officers, 833 Class-III employees and others.

Out of these 575 cases, 119 cases have been instituted for possession of disproportionate assets amounting to Rs.115,52,41,333/- (as per F.I.R) by 127 public servants and 50 private persons. Likewise, 233 Trap cases have been instituted against 248 public servants and 07 private persons for accepting illegal gratification from the complainants amounting to Rs.33,22,505/-.

Out of 119 Disproportionate Assets cases, in 35 DA cases, the amount of disproportionate assets, as per FIR, is more than One Crore. Likewise, out of 233 Trap cases, in 07 Trap cases, the bribe money recovered from the accused persons is more than One Lakh and in 21 trap cases, the bribe money recovered from the accused persons is more than Rs.30,000/-.

During this period, 334 persons have been arrested, which includes 36 Class-I officers, 30 Class-II officers, 268 Class-III employees and others.

The State Vigilance also registered this year 74 cases relating to allotment of plots by the BDA, CDA and Housing Board, which are under investigation.

During this period, as many as 661 file enquiries were initiated against 730 persons, which include 74 Class-I Officers, 112 Class-II Officers, 544 Class-III and others. Likewise, enquiry in respect

of 592 files were disposed of, basing on which, 270 criminal cases were registered, 183 enquiries were referred to different departments for initiation of departmental proceeding and 139 enquiries were closed.

During this period, 192 cases were disposed of by the Trial Courts, out of which, 83 cases ended in conviction, 95 cases ended in acquittal and 18 cases were abetted/dropped. Thus, the percentage of conviction comes to 47 %.

During this period, both the Special Courts disposed of 08 cases, out of which, 05 cases ended in conviction, 02 cases ended in acquittal and 01 case was abated. The Vigilance Department has initiated confiscation proceedings of disproportionate assets in 14 cases. During the period, final orders regarding confiscation of property have been passed in 03 cases.

The Sales Tax Wing of Vigilance has detected 48 tax Evasion Cases and collected Rs.2036.02 lakhs as tax and penalty.

The Forest Wing of Vigilance has conducted 110 joint raids and seized illegal timber and other forest produces worth Rs.2,86,85,785/-.
